Re: Inquiry Concerning Status of Direct Surety

Dear Ms. Johnson-Woods:

I am contacting you on behalf of the National Association of Surety Bond Producers (NASBP), a national trade association of companies employing licensed surety bond producers, including licensed resident and non-resident producers placing bonds in the State of California and in all other jurisdictions.

NASBP has recently had requests from members concerning the status of a business concern, Direct Surety, which is conducting surety business in the State of California and in other jurisdictions; but we are unclear as to whether Direct Surety is acting as a surety producer or as a surety insurer. The president of Direct Surety is David Druml.

We know from its advertising to the public that Direct Surety represents itself as establishing direct surety relationships with contractors without going through a middleman. For instance, on its website Direct Surety states as follows:

Direct Surety is positioned to be the leading U.S. provider of contract surety bonds enabling contractors to go direct to a surety underwriter rather than through a broker network. . . . The company's primary focus is providing contract surety bonds directly to contractors, eliminating the need for a middleman and promoting a strong relationship directly with a surety underwriter. . . .

NASBP's request is on what grounds and in what capacity is Direct Surety or its officers licensed in the state of California to act as a producer agency or to act as a surety insurer with a certificate of authority.
