



Make SURETY a CAREER



The NASBP Make Surety A Career Program curriculum packet for College/University Faculty was designed by NASBP using NASBP resource materials in consultation with Professor Kurt Krogull, Director of the Jack Lockton Certificate in Insurance and Risk Management at the University of Kansas School of Business. This packet includes materials on surety bonding that are designed to be included in collegiate-level insurance and business classes, focusing primarily on contract surety bonds for construction purposes. The packet helps students understand fundamental concepts, like what surety is and isn't, the parties to a surety bond, contract surety bonds vs. commercial surety bonds, types of contract bonds, and the three "Cs" of surety underwriting. Once a professor signs up for the curriculum packet, they also can gain access to all of NASBP's member resources on surety bonding!

The curriculum packet includes:

- "Introduction to Surety" slide presentation
- Sample contractor financial statements and surety case study template
- Quiz Question Bank
- Surety Career Videos
- Online request form for surety professionals as guest speakers for your class

Students additionally will have the ability to gain further knowledge independently through accessing an online, self-directed contract surety bonding course. Completion of the online course will provide a student with the option of requesting internship opportunities in the surety industry.

The online course also may be used by instructors for supplemental instruction to in-person classes.
